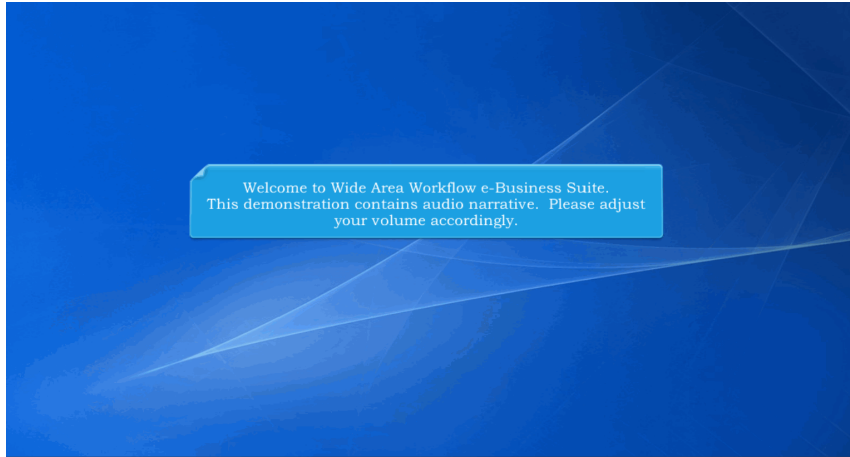
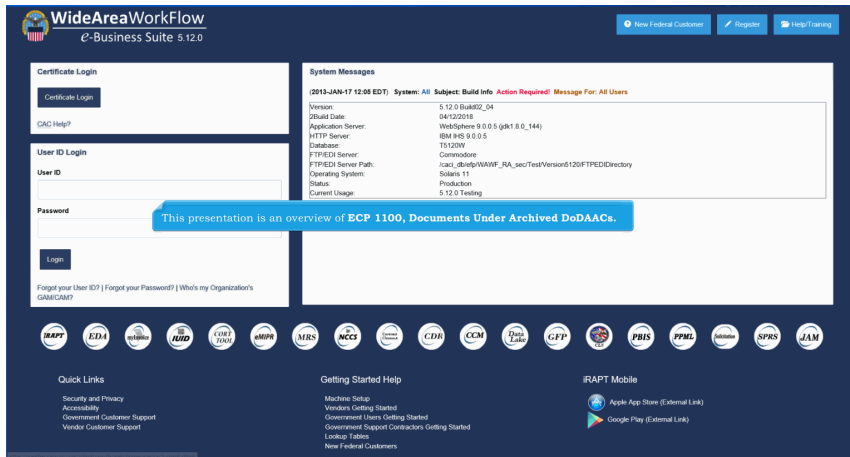

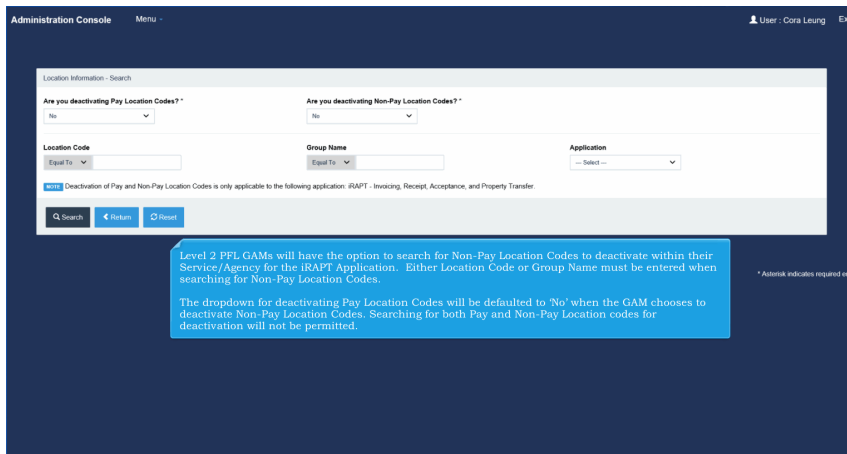

Step 1



This presentation is an overview of ECP 1100, Documents Under Archived DoDAACs.

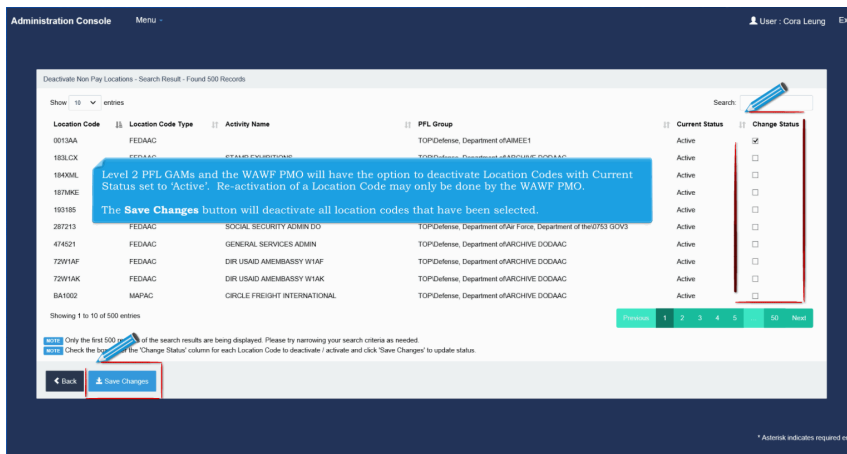
Step 2



Level 2 PFL GAMs will have the option to search for Non-Pay Location Codes to deactivate within their Service/Agency for the iRAPT Application. Either Location Code or Group Name must be entered when searching for Non-Pay Location Codes.

The dropdown for deactivating Pay Location Codes will be defaulted to 'No' when the GAM chooses to deactivate Non-Pay Location Codes. Searching for both Pay and Non-Pay Location codes for deactivation will not be permitted.

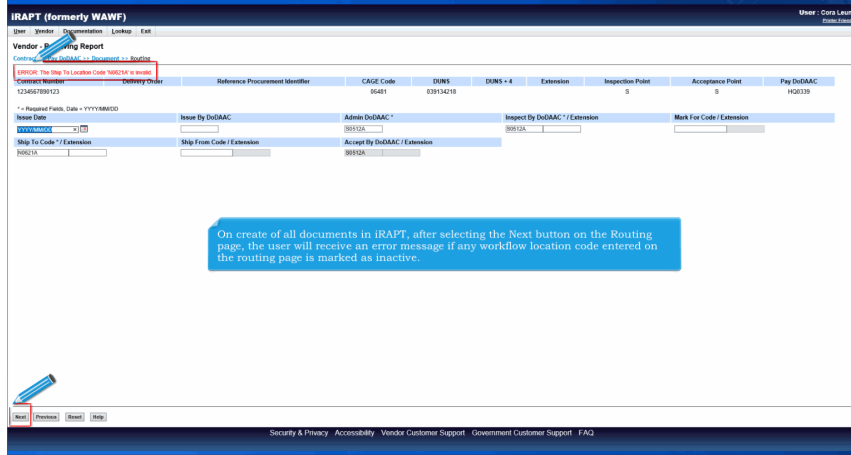
Step 3



Level 2 PFL GAMs and the WAWF PMO will have the option to deactivate Location Codes with Current Status set to 'Active'. Re-activation of a Location Code may only be done by the WAWF PMO.

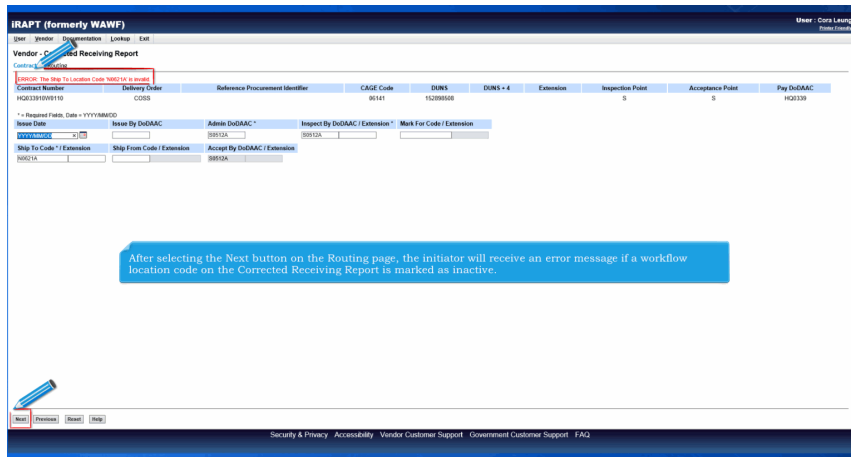
The Save Changes button will deactivate all location codes that have been selected.

Step 4



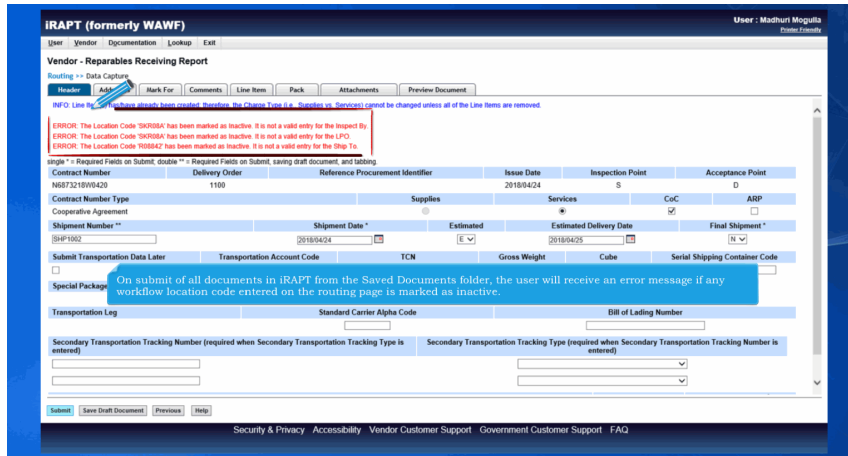
On create of all documents in iRAPT, after selecting the Next button on the Routing page, the user will receive an error message if any workflow location code entered on the routing page is marked as inactive.

Step 5



After selecting the Next button on the Routing page, the initiator will receive an error message if a workflow location code on the Corrected Receiving Report is marked as inactive.

Step 6



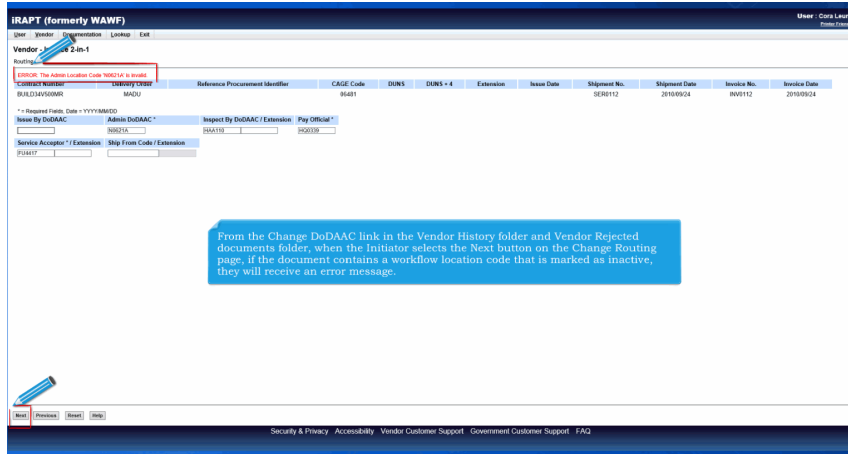
On submit of all documents in iRAPT from the Saved Documents folder, the user will receive an error message if any workflow location code entered on the routing page is marked as inactive.

Step 7



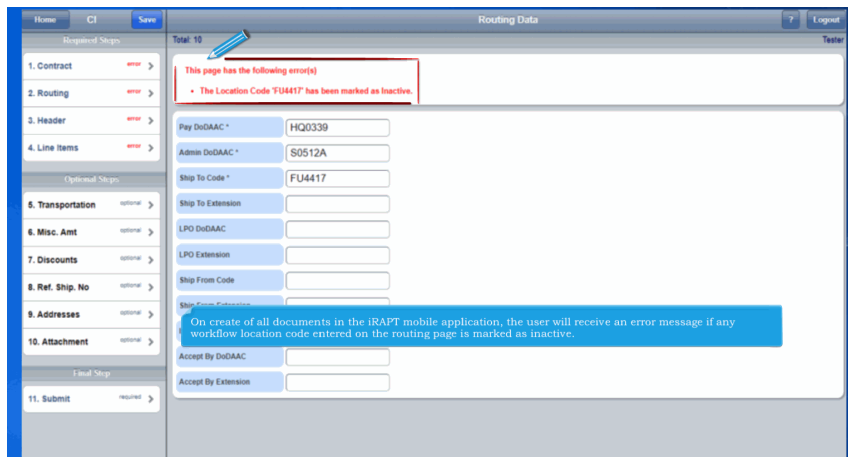
When opening a document from the Recall link in the Vendor History folder or the Resubmit link in the Vendor Rejected documents folder, if the document contains a location code that is marked as inactive, they will receive an error message. They will need to resubmit their document from the 'Change DoDAAC' link in each folder.

Step 8



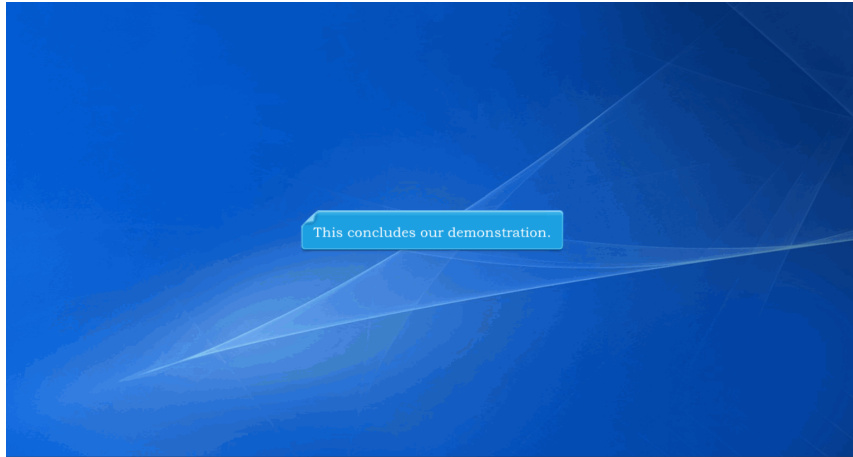
From the Change DoDAAC link in the Vendor History folder and Vendor Rejected documents folder, when the Initiator selects the Next button on the Change Routing page, if the document contains a workflow location code that is marked as inactive, they will receive an error message.

Step 9



On create of all documents in the iRAPT mobile application, the user will receive an error message if any workflow location code entered on the routing page is marked as inactive.
